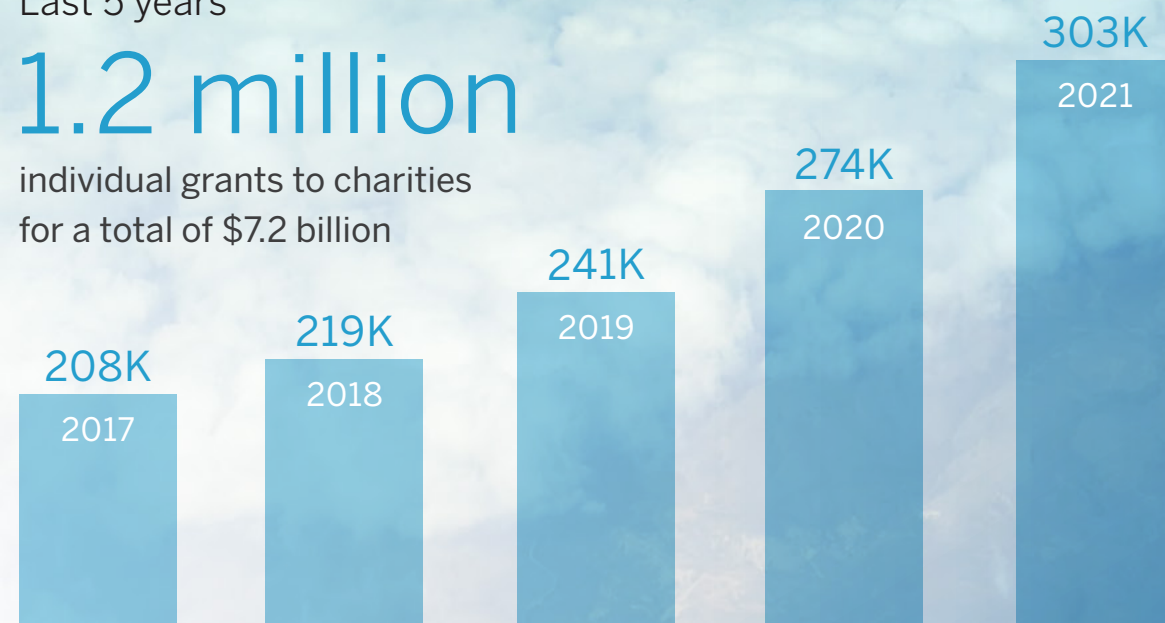

### COVID-19

COVID shook the world, but not your giving. From meals for schoolkids across the U.S. to protective gear for frontline healthcare workers, to airlifting medical supplies to countries around the globe – your giving knew no boundaries.



### HAITI EARTHQUAKE

You joined hands with charities, and even the U.S. Navy, to respond quickly to the devastation – utilizing a military landing craft and a specialized Navy boat to bring 6 million meals to 270,000 survivors across 369 Haitian communities.



### HURRICANE IDA

You empowered ingenuity in the wake of catastrophe – such as a distribution hub created in an unoccupied department store and mall parking lot, enabling tractor-trailers to dock, load, and transport relief supplies to those in need.



### AFGHANISTAN

Even with hundreds of thousands of Afghans displaced, you gave hope, which was in short supply, to those fleeing from danger. Dramatic rescues, critical supplies, temporary shelter – you helped bring lights in the darkness. And families continue to receive love and support as they're welcomed here as refugees.



### CALIFORNIA WILDFIRES

With 60,000+ Californians forced to evacuate their homes, you provided emergency overnight stays, care packages, and meals for firefighters and volunteers, as well as critical financial aid to 1,700 people who experienced total loss.
